

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Salt Eraser is an advanced salt neutralising formulation that removes salt deposits from the surface of your paved area or brickwork.

Not only does it remove the salts from the surface, it penetrates deep into the paved area or brickwork, helping to draw efflorescence up to the surface. This non-acid based formula can be used on any surface where salt build up occurs.

For reference, efflorescence is typically a naturally occurring phenomenon where salt deposits from the cement migrate up through the porous paved area or brickwork and appear on the surface.

## CHEMICAL COMPOSITION

Salt Eraser is formulated with a blend of synergistic organic compounds, surfactants and other activators.

- Neutralises the salt
- Does not alter the aesthetics or nature of the paved area
- Penetrates deep into the surface
- Non-flammable
- Non-caustic
- No hydrochloric acid
- No phosphoric acid

## COVERAGE

**1 Litre = 5m<sup>2</sup> to 10m<sup>2</sup>**  
**(33.8floz = 53ft<sup>2</sup> to 107ft<sup>2</sup>)**

The figures indicated are approximate and should only be used as a general guideline.

## STORAGE

Store in the original unopened container in a clean, dry area and ideally at 5°C - 25°C (41°F - 77°F). Use within 24 months from the date of manufacture.

## CLEANING EQUIPMENT

Clean tools and equipment immediately after use with water.

## APPLICATION

Always test a small inconspicuous area before proceeding to ensure the finished result is satisfactory. Shake the container well before use.

Generously apply to the surface using a low pressure spray unit or brush.

Allow the product to act for 1 hour and then reapply.

Leave for a further 24 hours and then wash away surface salts with a pressure washer or brush using a dilution of 1 part salt eraser to 50 parts water. If the salts/efflorescence reappears repeat this process.

Once dry, we recommend protecting the surface with a sealer from the Pavetuf range.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Must only be used when the temperature of the surfaces to be treated is <5°C and >25°C (<41°F and >77°F)

Not suitable for heavily contaminated areas.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY
